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






Subject: \$500 Stipend | Looking for older adults to participate in interviews about aging

I want to ask for your help. The SCAN Foundation is working with the Public Policy Lab on a project to improve how older Americans get healthcare and how policies that impact aging are made. The project team is looking to speak with about 8–10 older adults (65+) in and around [X location] for 2.5-hour, in-person interviews, around the week of [Y week]. Conversation will focus on participants' lives and experiences as an older adult. The content and themes from interviews conducted around the country will be compiled into a rich and searchable repository for policy- and decision-makers to better understand and serve the needs of older Americans.

For these interviews, the research team can travel directly to participants, ideally in their homes. Interviews can be conducted in English, Spanish, or Chinese. Participants will be paid \$200 for their time.

We also hope that participants will be able to complete follow-up activities over the course of the next few months. Participants will be paid in two intervals of \$150 for the completion of subsequent activities. These activities can be done on the participants' own time with materials the team will leave behind after the first visit, as well as some phone or on video call follow-up. Over the course of the project, participants can earn up to \$500 by engaging in all activities. Participants can be paid via physical Visa gift cards, Venmo, PayPal, ACH transfer, and more.

The team can also offer up to \$500 to community-based organizations for up to 10 hours of work that yields 8-10 local participants.

If you're an older adult who may be interested in this study, you can:










### Research Participants ▶ MOP 1206


79 YEARS OLD, HEBER, CA SPANISH

[Your children] grow up, slowly. That's the life of every human being. They say [they grow up] to take care of their parents, but it's a lie.






